Starting in February with the Spring Classic played in Jupiter, Florida at the Abacoa Golf Club and ending in early December with the Ralph Bogart, played at Crown Colony G&CC and The Forest Country Club in Ft. Myers.

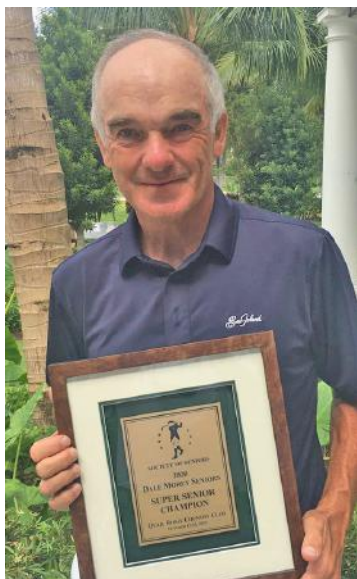
SENIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Craig Hurlbert, Magnolia, Texas has to spend the winter wearing two crowns. The Society of Seniors Senior Player Of The Year, and Amateurgolf.com's number one senior player of the year.

Hurlbert also finished the year in WAGR's number nine spot.

Four victories highlighted Craig's year to include the Old Corkscrew Senior, the Gateway Senior Invitational, the Golfweek Senior National Match Play and the SOS Founders Cup. Other notable finishes were five top-five finishes, and a tenth at the SOS Championship.

Hurlbert finished the year with 405 SOS POY points, good for a slim five-point edge over Macon, Georgia's Allen Peake at 400.



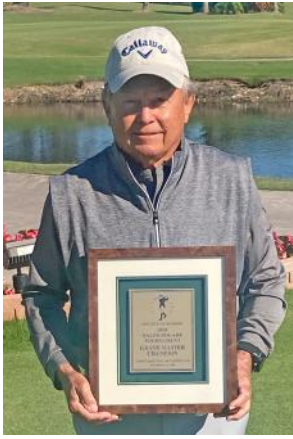
SUPER SENIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Marc Fried, Solon, Ohio started 2020 with a win at the 2020 Spring Classic, added a T27 at the National Super Senior Championship, a win at the Dale Morey Super Seniors, a 3rd at The Founders Cup and finished with an 8th place at the Ralph Bogart. Fried's 680 accumulated points was 75 ahead of Evan Long, Charlotte, N. Carolina at 605 points.

LEGEND PLAYER OF THE YEAR

George Washburn, Frederick, Maryland finished atop the Legend POY for the second straight year. George started the year at the Spring Classic with a T4 finish, traveled to the July Hesler where he won, followed with a T2 at the Morey Legends. Washburn topped off 2020 with a T12 at The Bogart. At 510 points, Washburn was a slim 55 points ahead of Johnny Blank, Frostburg, Maryland.





GRAND MASTER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Jim DuBois, Coral Springs, Florida didn't have to travel far for his first win in 2020. At the Spring Classic, just up the road in Jupiter, DuBois planted his flag with a three shot victory. His season had begun. DuBois followed with a T4 at the Hesler, a T4 at the Dale Morey Grand Masters, and a second place at the Founders Cup. DuBois finished 2020 as he started, with a win at the Bogart. Jim's 2020 points total was 770. Finishing second in the GM POY race was Californian Steve Wilson at 400 points.

SUPER GRAND MASTER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Harry Cain, Boynton Beach, Florida only plays on special occasions. His special occasions in 2020 included a 2nd at the Spring Classic, a win at the Dale Morey Super Grand Masters and a T3 at the Ralph Bogart.

Harry's 500 points was 40 points ahead of the world's nicest guy, Charlie Busbee, Stockbridge, Georgia.
